About the Winerv

Bonneau Winery is operated by the third generation of Bonneaus with family history dating back to the early 1920s in Sonoma, California. Catherine & Auguste Bonneau originally came to America from the vineyard lands near Tarn, France and began farming a 70 acre parcel of land just south of the town of Sonoma. After growing and providing Chardonnay grapes to several well-known wineries in both Sonoma and Napa, the family launched its own brand in 2002.

Pinot grapes for this wine are carefully selected and hand picked at the Sangiacomo Vineyard of the Sonoma Coast appellation. Winemaking operations take place in Sonoma where the wine is fermented and aged to perfection.

John Bambury is the Director of Winemaking and handles all the winemaking responsibilities.

Winemaker Notes: The grapes for our 2013 Pinot Noir come from the prestigious Sangiacomo Vineyards that lie within the Sonoma Coast growing region. In the glass, this wine shows off its crystal garnet color with aromas of ripe black cherries, pomegranate, and rose petal. Well balanced, supple tannins dance across the palate accentuating this wine's deep fruit and spices. Flavors of pomegranate, wild strawberry, cola, and clove spice follow the tannins and acidity through to the long elegant finish.
