About the Winery

Bonneau Winery is operated by the third generation of Bonneaus with family history dating back to the early 1920s in the Sonoma-Los Carneros appellation. The Bonneaus originally came to America from the vineyard lands of Bordeaux. France and began farming a 70 acre parcel of land just south of the town of Sonoma. After growing and providing Chardonnay grapes to several well-known wineries in both Sonoma and Napa, the family launched its own label in 2002.

This rare combination of Malbec grapes were harvested from both the north and south ends of Sonoma Valley offering the influences of the cooler, southern exposure, complemented by the longer ripening time in the warmer northern valley. Winery operations take place in the town of Sonoma.

Winemaker Notes: Our 2012 Malbec grapes were harvested from the Hunter Vineyard in Sonoma Valley and the Hernandez Vineyard in Sonoma Carneros appellations. The grapes were picked at full maturity and optimal ripeness in order to take advantage of their deep, rich varietal flavors. Its dark red garnet color and purple hues alludes to the wine's intensity and structural depth. It has enticing aromas and flavors of mountain blueberries, black raspberries, baking spice, anise, and sweet vanilla oak. The wine is medium-bodied, succulent and juicy on the palate, with fully integrated tannins, well-balanced acidity, and a full mouth feel. Its flavors reflect its aromas and they resonate across the palate with an explosion of berry flavors, spice, oak and a lingering finish.
